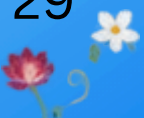
# CCA DAY

After serving a span of almost 20 -30 years in this institute they would now relax with their family members in their 2nd innings. We wish them a healthy and happy retired life

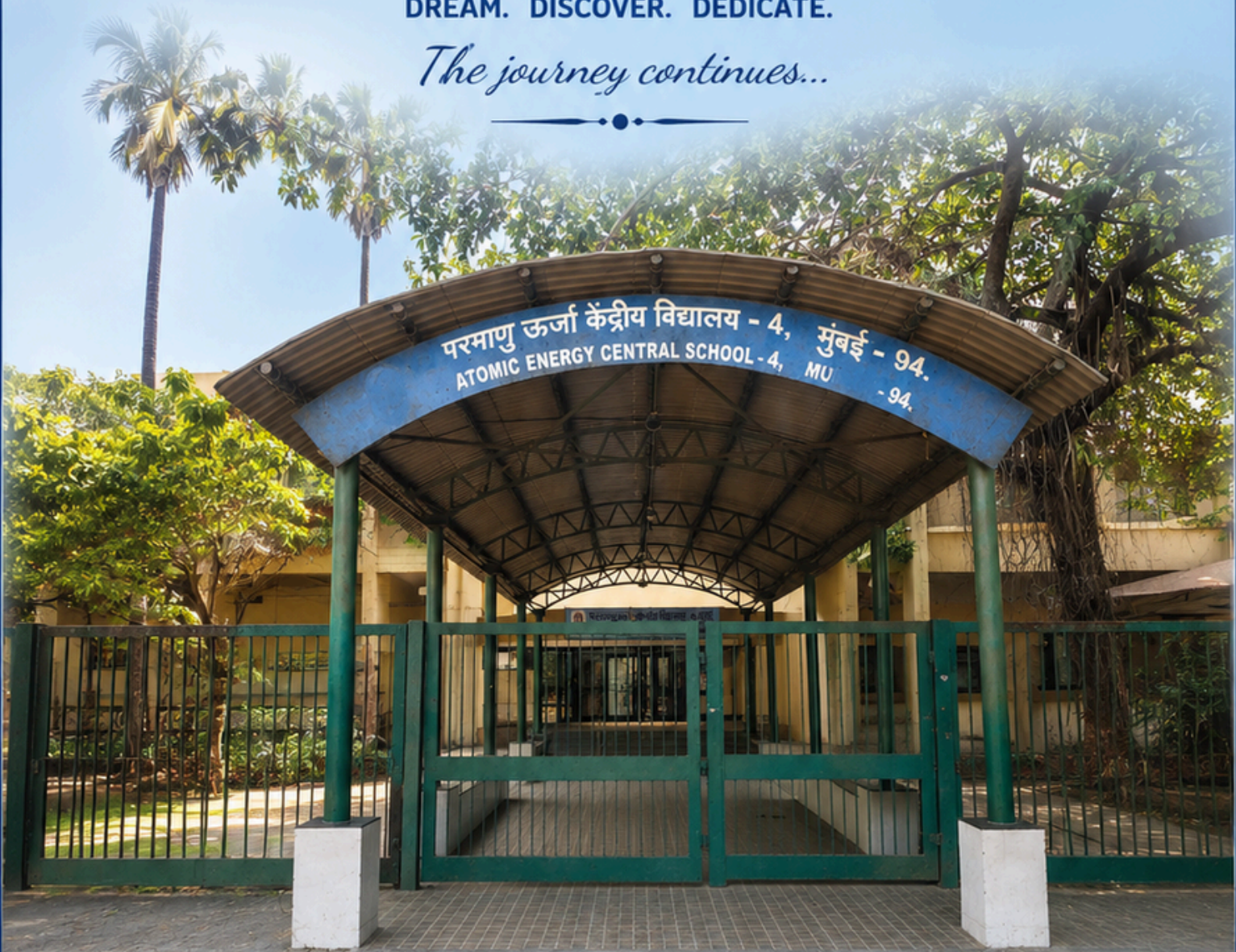
