






The basic philosophy of his and his team is that Space is for everyone and it is currently expensive, they are putting all efforts to make it affordable especially for students, which will help in further space exploration at a larger scale and at cheaper rates.

He is under the mentorship of Dr. Archana Sharma, Senior Scientist at CERN, Geneva appointed as Senior Advisors for relations with International organizations, the only Indian in the staff of CERN involved in discovery of Higgs Boson particle, in 2012.

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
CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES


